Commandment 3

## Deuteronomy 5:12-15

12 Keep the sabbath day to sanctify it, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee. 13 Six days thou shalt labour , and do all thy work: 14 But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thine ox, nor thine ass, nor any of thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates; that thy manservant and thy maidservant may rest as well as thou.

## Deuteronomy 5:12-15

15 And remember that thou wast a servant in the land of Egypt, and that the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: therefore the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day.

## Deuteronomy 5:11

- “Keep” – to watch, observe, and remember
- Sanctify – to set apart, consecrate, devote
- Labour – work, service,
- Sabbath- day of atonement

## Deuteronomy 5:11

- I. **Pause**
  - for the People – God required his people to take a pause from their gathering, and toiling to ensure they wouldn’t push themselves to death as had been their dilemma in Egypt.
    - (Exodus 16:29, Leviticus 23:3)
  - For their Property – Overworking their land and the livestock was taken away through the Sabbath. (Leviticus 26:34-35, 43)

### II. Peace

- a. with Man – It was a requirement to have personal disagreements settled for atonement to be accepted.
- b. with God – atonement brought peace with God through the sacrificial system. (Leviticus 24:8)
