## Deuteronomy 5:16

*“Honor thy father and thy mother, as the Lord thy God hath commanded thee; that thy days may be prolonged, and that it may go well with thee, in the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.”*

## Deuteronomy 5:16

- “Honor”— to make heavy, glorious, make rich
- father – originator or patron of a class, founder of a household, family, group or clan
- Commanded – charged, appointed, charged

## ***Honor thy Father and thy Mother***

### **I. Conduct**

- Obedience – Paul instructs the children to obey their parents or to hear their instruction.
  - (Ephesians 6:1-3; Colossians 3:20)
- Obligation – There is implied obligation on behalf of both parties. Parents must instruct and children must listen. (Ephesians 6:4; Proverb 22:6)

## ***Honor thy Father and thy Mother***

### **II. Connections**

- Father - originator or patron of a class, founder of a household, family, group or clan
  - Genesis 18:17-19
- Mother - the starting point of life and nurturer of the family unit.
- Parents – are specified as being the fountains of domestic authority.

### **III. Consequences**

- a. Prolonged Life – “That your days may be prolonged. (Deuteronomy 5:16b)
- b. Peaceful Life – “and that it may go well with thee, in the land which the Lord thy God gives thee. (Jeremiah 35:5-9; 14, 18-19; Luke 15:11-32)
